With boomer influences and Gen Z humor, they write, compose, and perform while making us groove.

Nostalgia at its best! The crackle of vinyl in the family living room, pop-culture references from the '80s and '90s. It's a utopian golden age reinvented with meticulous, soulful work and exceptional musicians. Eight years after "All In," (their first album) they return with "Tomorrow Can Wait," (oct. 2024) blending retro sound with contemporary pop. Ten tracks offer rounded pop, close to new wave, with a retro-funk vibe and energetic backing vocals. It's full of groove, making us sway from head to hips, perfect for an impromptu dancefloor.

And while for the younger among us, this delicate, polished album will sound rather current, others will enjoy plunging back into an era when the Game Boy reigned supreme.
